## **Message 1: Jesus REVEALED**

## **Discussion Questions:**

- 1. Read Revelation 1:12-18. What stands out to you about John's vision of Jesus? How does this description compare to how Jesus is often pictured or thought of today?
- 2. Why do you think John uses such powerful imagery to describe Jesus? How does this vision of Christ encourage believers facing trials?
- 3. Read Revelation 5:6-14. Why is Jesus described as both a "Lion" and a "Lamb"? What does this paradox teach us about how Jesus rules?
- 4. In Revelation 5:9-10, the people sing a new song to Jesus. How does their song help us understand the significance of Jesus' sacrifice?
- 5. Read Revelation 19:11-16. Jesus is depicted as the rider on the white horse. What does it mean that His weapon is a sword from His mouth rather than in His hand?
- 6. How do these images of Jesus challenge or expand your current understanding of who He is?
- 7. How does seeing Jesus as the Ancient of Days, the Slain Lamb, and the Victorious King help us endure through life's difficulties?
- 8. What are some ways we can reflect this vision of Jesus in our daily lives? How does knowing He is both sacrificial and victorious impact how we follow Him?
- 9. Why do you think Revelation emphasizes Jesus' glory and victory in such dramatic ways? How does this compare to other parts of Scripture?
- 10. How does worshiping Jesus as Revelation describes help reorient our perspective on the challenges we face today?
