Message 2: The Church is Revealed

Discussion Questions:

- 1. What does the metaphor "Team Lamb" help you understand about the identity and purpose of the Church?
- 2. Read Revelation 1:12–13. Why do you think Jesus appears "in the midst" of the lampstands? What does that say about His relationship to the Church?
- 3. Look at the letters to the seven churches in Revelation 2–3. Which church do you most identify with—and why?
- 4. What does it mean for a church today to "shine" like a lampstand in the darkness? Where do you see that happening—or not happening?
- 5. Revelation 4–5 shows all of heaven worshiping the Lamb. How might that vision reframe the way you think about what we do in church each week?
- 6. Revelation 5:9–10 says we are a kingdom of priests. What does that priestly identity mean for your life at home, work, or in your community?
- 7. What stood out to you about the story of the two witnesses in Revelation 11? How does their journey mirror the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus?
- 8. Revelation 14:4 describes the faithful as "those who follow the Lamb wherever He goes." What might that look like in your life right now?
- 9. Where in your life are you tempted to compromise your witness—either by hiding your light or going along with the crowd?
- 10. The message ended with this call: "Don't just wear the jersey—live the mission." What's one way you can more fully live like you're on Team Lamb this week?
